Television interviews held in 2015 and 2016 on Bahrain's interdiction on foreign press

2016 2017

13 June

Arrested in house raid for case 1.

28 December

Released on bail, immediately re-arrested for case 2.

February

Nabeel Rajab has been in pretrial detention for over 250 days.

To date, the trial for case 1 has been postponed 11 times.

To date, the trial for case 2 has been postponed 3 times.



How many years in prison does he face?

Nabeel Rajab is facing multiple charges, and therefore risks being sent to prison for all cases combined.

Charges: Case 1

"Spreading rumours in wartime",

"Insulting a neighbouring country [Saudi Arabia]",

"Offending a statutory body"

Charges: Case 2

Spreading false information and malicious rumors about domestic matters with the aim of discrediting and adversely affecting the State prestige.

If convicted on all charges, Nabeel Rajab is facing up to 18 years in prison

Bahraini Penal Code

Article 133: up to 10 years

• Article 215: up to 2 years

• Article 216: up to 3 years

• Article 134: **up to 3 years**
